EITC Qualifications:

- Must have earned income
- Must have a valid Social Security number
- Cannot file as married filing separate
- Generally cannot be a nonresident alien
- Cannot be filing Form 2555 or Form 2555-EZ
- Investment income must be \$3,100 or less
- Cannot be a qualifying child of another person

Income Eligibility Guidelines

Earned income and adjusted gross income (AGI) must each be less than:

- \$43,998 or (\$49,078 married filing jointly) with 3 or more qualifying children
- \$40,964 or (\$46,044 married filing jointly) with 2 qualifying children
- \$36,052 or (\$41,132 married filing jointly) with 1 qualifying child
- \$13,660 or (\$18,740 married filing jointly) with no qualifying children

What you need to bring:

- Social security card for each person on the tax return
- Photo identification
- All 2011 income documents (W-2, W-2G, F-1099s, F-1099R) from all employers and banks
- Copy of last year's tax return
- Childcare provider name, address and tax ID number
- Bank account and routing number for direct deposit (if applicable)
