



SIDNEY / POTTERY CORRIDOR STUDY

The City of Port Orchard has experienced significant annexation and development along the Sidney Road / Pottery Avenue Corridor stretching from Tremont Street in the North to Sedgwick Boulevard to the South.

The Sidney / Pottery Corridor Study is a public process with a focus upon the much needed transportation improvements to ensure this vital North-South corridor functions well for motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians, not only in the upcoming years, but long into the future. Roadway standards for this transportation corridor are envisioned to include roadway design, sidewalks, bike paths, coordinated street lighting, bus shelters, coordinated landscaping, and street furniture.

This study is intended to provide the entire length with not only an aesthetically pleasing thoroughfare but to also provide a tool for any future development along the corridor. A component of the public out reach for this project is the creation of a Sidney/Pottery Corridor Study subcommittee consisting of Planning Commission members and interested members of the public. Significant input from the Public Works Department and City Engineer will be an essential element of this planning process. Your input is needed in this effort and comments are requested from all property owners & citizens.
